Community members interested in recovery can get off the streets at any time.



ABOUT 4 WEEKS

OFF THE STREETS 1

Clients attend classes and meetings to decide if the program is for them.



IBOUT 2 WEEKS

OFF THE STREETS 2

Residents continue classes and meetings, obtain sponsors, and commit to recovery.



9-5 MONTHS

The heart of the program. Clients focus on recovery at their own pace, applying principles of the 12 steps.



5 WEEKS

CARITAS WORKS

Clients learn and practice the skills they need to find and keep a job.



90 DAYS OR MORE

TRANSITION

Clients prepare to move out on their own and re-enter the community.
