ABOUT 4 WEEKS

## OFF THE STREETS 1

Clients attend classes and meetings to decide if the program is for them.



ABOUT 2 WEEKS

## OFF THE STREETS 2

Residents continue classes and meetings, obtain sponsors, and commit to recovery.



4-5 MONTHS

## PHASE

The heart of the program. Clients focus on recovery at their own pace, applying principles of the 12 steps.



5 WEEKS

## CARITAS WORKS

Clients learn and practice the skills they need to find and keep a job.



90 DAYS OR MORE

## TRANSITION

Clients prepare to move out on their own and re-enter the community.

Alumni are encouraged to return and engage with those in the program.



# The Healing Place



The Healing Place (THP) is a long-term residential recovery program that includes a workforce development program, a transitional sober living community, and an active Alumni Association to sustain lifelong sobriety.

In 2020, we're celebrating 15 years of service to the Richmond community and beyond. THP has provided the tools and resources for sobriety, employment, and spiritual wellness for more than 8,000 men.

Services are provided at no cost for men and will be available for women in 2020.
