<b>Antidepressants</b> <i>Paxil, Zoloft, Cymbalta, Lexapro, etc.</i>	<b>Lisinopril</b> <i>high blood pressure and heart failure</i>	<b>Dilaudid</b> <b>Hydromorphone</b> <i>Opioid</i>	<b>Robaxin</b> <b>Methocarbamol</b> <i>Muscle relaxant</i>
<b>Buspar-Buspirone</b> <i>for anxiety</i>	<b>Metformin/Gyburide</b> <i>helps control blood sugar levels</i>	<b>Fentanyl</b> <i>Opioid</i>	<b>Seroquel</b> <b>Quetiapine</b> <i>Antipsychotic</i>
<b>Carbatrol/Tegretol-Carbamazepine</b> <i>treat seizures</i>	<b>Metoprolol</b> <i>high blood pressure, chest pain (angina), heart failure</i>	<b>Fioricet</b> <b>Butibaraital</b> <i>Barbiturate</i>	<b>Suboxone</b> <b>Subutex</b> <i>Narcotic</i>
<b>Carvedilol</b> <i>for high blood pressure</i>	<b>Phenobarbital</b> <i>prevents seizure, short-term as a sedative</i>	<b>Flexeril</b> <b>Cyclobenzaprine</b> <i>Muscle Relaxant</i>	<b>Thorazine</b> <b>Chlorpromazine</b> <i>Antipsychotic</i>
<b>Citalopram –Celexa</b> <i>antidepressant</i>	<b>Prednisone</b> <i>inflammation</i>	<b>Gabapentin-Neurontin</b> <i>Anticonvulsant - nerve pain</i>	<b>Tramadol</b> <i>Narcotic</i>
<b>Catapres-Clonidine</b> , <i>high blood pressure, relaxant</i>	<b>Prazosin-Minipress</b> <i>high blood pressure, PTSD, sleep (veterans)</i>	<b>Geodon</b> <i>Psychotropic</i>	<b>Trazodone</b> <b>Desyrel</b> <i>Sedative</i>
<b>Depakote</b> <i>seizures, bipolar &amp; migraine</i>	<b>Remeron – Mirtazapine</b> <i>anxiety, OCD, panic attacks, IBS, lack of appetite &amp; anger</i>	<b>Haldol - Haloperidol</b> <i>Antipsychotic</i>	<b>Valium</b> <b>Diazepam</b> <i>Anxiolytic and Sedative</i>
<b>Digoxin</b> <i>treat heart failure</i>	<b>Statins</b> <i>Atorvastatin (Lipitor)</i> <i>Simvastatin (Zocor)</i> <i>high cholesterol</i>	<b>Hypercodone</b> <b>Zohydro</b> <i>Opioid</i>	<b>Xanax</b> <b>Alprazolam</b> <i>Benzodiazepines</i>
<b>Dilantin- Phenytoin</b> <i>treat &amp; prevent seizures</i>	<b>Tessalon Perles</b> <i>cough</i>	<b>Hydroxyzine-Vistaril</b> <i>Antihistamine - anxiety</i>	
<b>Doxycycline</b> <i>for infections</i>	<b>Topamax- Topiramate</b> <i>migraine headaches, bipolar</i>	<b>Klonopin - Clonazepam</b> <i>Sedative</i>	
<b>Fluoxetine-Prozac</b> <i>treat depression, OCD</i>	<b>Trileptal – Oxcarbazepine</b> <i>epileptic seizures</i>	<b>Librium</b> <b>Chlordiazepoxide</b> <i>Sedative</i>	* Note to participant: If medications on the “not acceptable” list are being taken and not disclosed at time of phone screen its grounds for immediate dismissal.
<b>Guaifenesin- non DM</b> <i>reduce chest congestion</i>	<b>Vivitrol</b> <i>Opioid blocker</i>	<b>Methadone</b> <i>Narcotic</i>
