What I experienced instead was the brilliance and light of a shared community. When asked by my cherished friends about my first day back, I described it as a "love bubble." Yes, grief was present, but the love, empathy, solidarity, and connection were soothing balms I did not expect. Returning to work while navigating the greatest loss of my life, I was met with the support of many who have endured similar pain and much more.

Our participants and staff became my role models, reminding me that:

- → Life does indeed go on.
- → A compassionate community that gives a sense of belonging can make all the difference in facing and healing from trauma.

→ Life will not be the same, but we can laugh, smile, love, care, and feel again.

My heart was full of gratitude and peace, a great warmth surrounded me, and I was smiling through my tears. I can only imagine what this feels like for someone who has been without housing, health care, or family support.

As I reflected, I realized why CARITAS is a safe place—both to heal and to rebuild what is lost. This community thrives on vulnerability, trust, and love. Thanks to your support, EVERYONE has the opportunity to heal, rebuild, and ignite their untapped potential. With a faith-filled heart, I know I will heal, survive, and thrive again—and so will those we serve.

CARITAS is the largest provider of 24/7 shelter in the Richmond region and maintains the longest-running adult shelter in the area.

Our low-barrier shelter has served some of the highest-need participants experiencing chronic homelessness. THE STORY BEHIND THE HEALING

Meet Patrina.

She came to CARITAS to get back on track after a COVID diagnosis threatened to take everything she had. Her story is one of humility, determination, and gratitude:

"Before CARITAS, life was chaotic. I got so sick—first I had COVID, and then it was a constant cycle of appointments, tests, and illnesses. Because of that, I went into a deep depression, lost my job, and eventually had to give up my home and my car. I didn't want to burden my kids by staying with them, so I applied for shelter. It was the best thing that's happened to me in a long time—I actually worked in a shelter for nine and a half years and thought I knew what to expect, but **CARITAS gave me a new perspective and so much hope**. The shelter removed a lot of things to worry about. I could take the free city buses, I had food, I was safe. I didn't have to worry about those things and I could think clearly enough to focus on what I needed to do next.

When I got a job and my own place, it was bittersweet to leave. When things get tough, I remind myself that this is what I prayed for, this is what I hoped for, this is what I worked for, and I'm just grateful for the opportunity. Today, I'm working in a shelter again! I get to be around people who are experiencing situations similar to mine, and they just need somebody who can relate and give them compassion. **I'm very fortunate that I was able to find a place to be safe and heal while I was going through that.**"

The Healing Place continues to be a safe place to heal and rebuild. It is open 24/7/365 and offers recovery services at no cost

The Healing Place is our long-term, peer-driven, residential recovery program. Here, men and women experiencing substance use disorder carve pathways to sobriety, employment, and wellness. The Healing Place program also includes a workforce development program, a transitional sober living community, and an active Alumni Association to support lifelong sobriety.

THE STORY BEHIND THE HEALING

Meet Danny.

He came to CARITAS through The Healing Place to begin his recovery journey, and after completing the Works Program, he's living a full life. Here's his story:

"At sixteen, I left New Jersey for Richmond, drifting through life without direction. Drugs and alcohol became the escape from my high school years until I was 35. Multiple DUIs, legal trouble, and heartbreak led me to The Healing Place. **There, I discovered structure, support, and purpose with a group of men who were in the same situation as me, trying to do the same thing as me.** Nothing was asked of me other than to work on myself. It was hard because I don't like change. But somebody told me 'The reason we don't like change is just because it's uncomfortable.' It set me on a new pathway. I stuck with it and finished the program because it was so inclusive and there was a really strong sense of community.

Today, I spend my time as a father to my amazing kindergartner, and I work for myself as a brick-layer which gives me the ability to be present and there for my son. That is the most amazing thing and the best gift in the world—to be present 100%. I'm excited to remain healthy, to keep being a present father, and to be a responsible member of society. That feels freeing. CARITAS is a beautiful place that doesn't exist anywhere else. I still have very close connections to the people who work there. If anything ever comes up—I know I have them."

For people seeking a safe and supportive place to continue their recovery journey, CARITAS provides a sober living environment through its Recovery Residences. More than 60 partner agencies in our area work with the CARITAS Furniture Bank to provide essential household items for their clients in need.

Individuals living with us in our Recovery Residences are able to save money, foster independence, and plan for the future while receiving critical resources that support their recovery, employment opportunities, and self-esteem.

For individuals emerging from homelessness, escaping domestic violence, rebuilding after a disaster, or facing other barriers to "home," the Furniture Bank helps eliminate tough choices between furnishings and other financial commitments.

YOU GAVE Self-Sufficiency Grew

CARITAS Works helps individuals facing major employment barriers gain the skills and opportunities needed for sustainable employment.

Works provides a three-part workforce development program:

- 01 Works is a six-week, 160-hour program that encompasses character-building, career development, life skills, and computer training, with a condensed version available for individuals in the emergency shelters.
- 02 Job Club provides access to the computer lab, employment resources, personal assistance with job applications, and resources to support employment opportunities.
- 03 AfterWorks offers two years of job placement support and follow-up, including a variety of wraparound services to help them develop their careers.


